Title: Translational Addiction Research

The main goal of the Translational Addiction Research Laboratory is to improve the treatment and understanding of drug addiction. We have active research in areas of opioids, alcohol, tobacco and cannabis

1. **Clinical trials in Addiction: we are part of multiple site RCT evaluating different treatment modalities for opoiod use disorder. We are using laboratory based study (cannabis, alcohol, tobacco administration)**
2. **We are performing epidemiological studies on addiction using NESARC data base. This has been successful to allow trainees to get publications**
3. **We are doing brain imaging studies using PET imaging approach**
