THERAPEUTIC COMMUNICATION ELECTIVE

MEET (Making Every Encounter Therapeutic)

MEET is an elective experience offered to second year pre-clerkship medical students at the University of Toronto that focuses on therapeutic communication skills in the context of the interaction between mental and physical health. The elective involves 1:1 interaction with a teacher to develop communication skills and that it is geared towards all medical students (not just those interested in mental health). It is based on the idea that patients and their health care professionals can engage in conversations that are healing. Involving patients with both physical and mental health conditions means that it is applicable to many patients you will see across clinical settings and disciplines.

WHAT

- 4 sessions total 90-minute orientation and debrief session, as well as two-90 minute sessions with a teacher (1:1 communication skills coaching sessions)
- Sessions with patients involve approximately 45 minutes of direct patient contact along with a 45 minute debrief session in which patients, teachers and students have a chance to discuss the interview experience
- You must commit to all 4 sessions in order to participate
- Other than assigned pre-readings, there is no additional work outside of the 4 sessions.

WHO

- 2nd Year Pre-Clerkship Medical Students (**6o spots** available).
- This course is open to **all 2**nd **year** medical students, not just those who are interested in psychiatry
