The main goal of the Translational Addiction Research Laboratory is to improve the treatment and understanding of drug addiction. We have active research program funded by CIHR and NIH and multiple funding sources. Current studies are in areas of opioids, alcohol, tobacco and cannabis

1. **Clinical trials in Addiction: we are performing innovative RCT for addiction treatment**
2. **We are using laboratory based study (cannabis, alcohol, tobacco administration) to study determinant of drug use**
3. **We are performing epidemiological studies on addiction**
4. **We are doing brain imaging studies using PET imaging approach**
